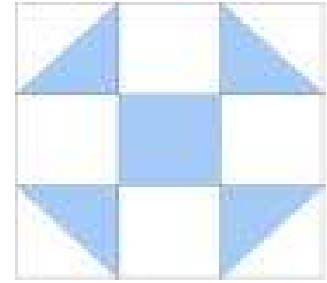




# Homemade Blankets for Kenya

It is estimated that there are at least one million AIDS orphans in Kenya. The number of orphans is rapidly growing and Kenyans are having difficulty keeping up with their new social demands. Many Kenyan children live in severe poverty. Often these children are plagued with diseases or congenital defects.

We would like to give you an opportunity to help a child in Kenya in a practical way. You can help in a personal way by creating a homemade blanket which we will distribute to children while we are in Kenya. This would meet some of their physical needs as well as some of their emotional needs.

We are looking for:

1. **baby blankets** – approx. 30 x 40 inches (or panel size)
2. **children's blankets** – approx. 45 x 60 inches

Feel free to sew, knit, or crochet your homemade blanket. You can use any material that you feel is suitable and durable.
